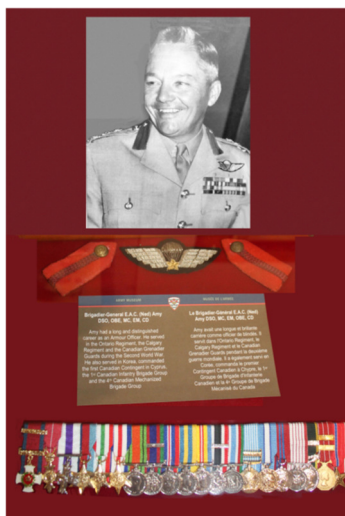

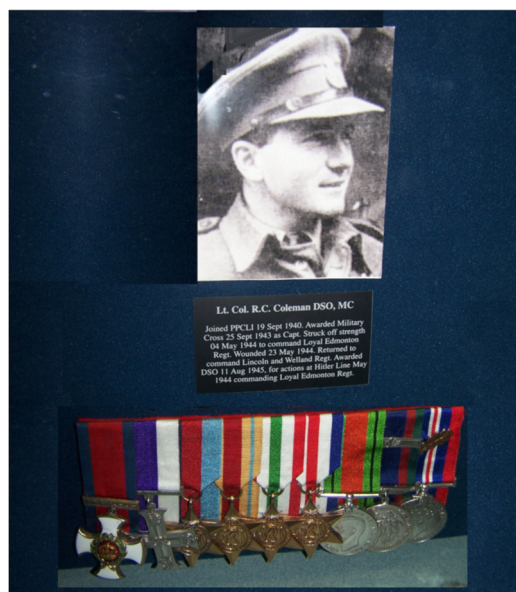

On 8 November 1942 during the attack on Fort Duperre (Algiers), Captain Lieven was acting as Political and Liaison Officer. On at least six occasions he advanced within 30 yards of the fort in attempts to parley with the garrison. On each occasion he was met with shots from snipers. He was quite undeterred by this and showed complete disregard for his own safety.

Colin Douglas Nickerson was born on 11 March 1919 in Ottawa and died on 2 October 2015 in the Veteran's Unit, Fisherman's Memorial Hospital, Lunenburg, NS, with family at his side. He was the only son of James Stanley and Rose Marie (Gambrill) Nickerson. He is survived by his wife of 70 years, Emma Jean and children: James (Ann Marie), Jane (Tom), John and Joan, 4 grandchildren: Matthew, Laura and Angela Schwarzkopf and Sylvia Nickerson, and 4 great grandchildren: Otto, Paisley, Colin and Lillian.

As a Minister's son he attended various schools notably in Berwick and Leitches Creek. He worked in the Sydney Steel Mines before joining the war effort enlisting as a Princess Louise Fusilier. After training in England he went to Northern Italy, initially in Signals and then Artillery, receiving a Battlefield Commission later on. He fought in Ortona on the Gustav and Hitler lines. He was wounded twice and awarded the Military Cross. He returned to the battlefield in 1944 on the Gothic line where he lost his left arm to a German 88 millimeter.

Upon returning to Mahone Bay he met and married Emma Jean Burgoyne in March of 1945 and had four children. He returned to school at Mount Allison, and rejoined the Army as a Chaplain after receiving a Medical Exemption. His humanitarian efforts were recognized with the awarding of the Order of Saint John and an Honorary Doctorate of Divinity, from the Atlantic School of Theology. He retired as the Chaplain General in 1978. He was proud to have served his country for over 30 years in every rank from Private to Brigadier General. He returned to Nova Scotia a year later where he settled back in Mahone Bay and enjoyed gardening, curling and up to 4 cats. As a member of the Mahone Bay Legion he advocated for many local War Veterans.
