 16/10/1989 Won Senate Seat received 41.7% of the more than 620,000 non-binding votes cast by Albertans  
 11/06/1990 **Senator** Non-binding result did end with him appointed to a Senate Seat  
 26/09/1991 Senator Died of complications resulting from a brain tumor
